Affordable Housing

Subsidized housing generally administered by Housing Authority, other non-profit organizations, or private companies

Public Housing

Housing developments or single family dwellings that are owned and managed by local housing authorities and rented to income and program eligible individuals and families. Eligible households pay approximately 30% of their adjusted gross income for rent.
