## **Minutes**

### **Fun Run Summary**

- The Workforce Housing fund raised \$1,675 in the Fun Run this year.

### **ADU Proposal**

- Jim Dufour, Walter Clapp, John Bueg, Al Bloomer have been developing the “Workforce Dwelling Unit” concept for 6-7 months as a solution to the lack of long-term rentals in Red Lodge. Their proposal is to locate small Workforce Dwelling Units on residential properties within Red Lodge City Limits; requiring a collaborative effort between business owners, property owners, local financiers, and the City of Red Lodge.
- They have interested funders / partners in place and are hoping to work with business owners, property owners, financiers, the City, and other community stakeholders to refine and implement.
- Units will be identical and roughly 300 square feet.
- RLACF involvement: we can potentially assist with connecting to resources and potential partners, finding funding, educating homeowners/renters, etc...

### **VISTA quarterly service update / Economic Summary presentation**

- Economic Summary: see report for full summary. Takeaways:
  - a. Unemployment rate in Carbon County is currently lower than pre-pandemic levels.
  - b. Average home price in Carbon County increased 72% 2016 – 2020. The median price of single-family homes in 2020 was \$114,000 higher than what average wage earners in the county can afford.
  - c. 46.4% of renters in the county are “cost-burdened”, or paying more than 30% of their income on rent and utilities.
  - d. In the second quarter of 2021, there were 151 active short-term rental units listed on Airbnb and VRBO within the City of Red Lodge. There are 268 units listed in the 59068 zip code, a 50% increase over the last two years.
- Service Update
  - a. Volunteers

- i. July – September there were 38 volunteers accumulating 326 hours at the Spires
  - ii. Red Lodge High School is successfully partnering with us and Helena Habitat to offer students hand-on construction experience at the build site 4 days a week
  - iii. [Community Build Day November 13<sup>th</sup> 8:30am – 4pm](#), lunch sponsored by Pizza Co
- b. Housing Needs Assessment
  - i. Survey to be released in November to whole County
  - ii. Final results and analysis set to be released in early January
- c. Long-Term Rental Research and Recommendations
  - i. Currently in researching phase, developing incentive program for landlords to make units available to long-term renters
- d. Housing Strategic Plan
  - i. Will begin after needs assessment is complete potentially in partnership with Future West
